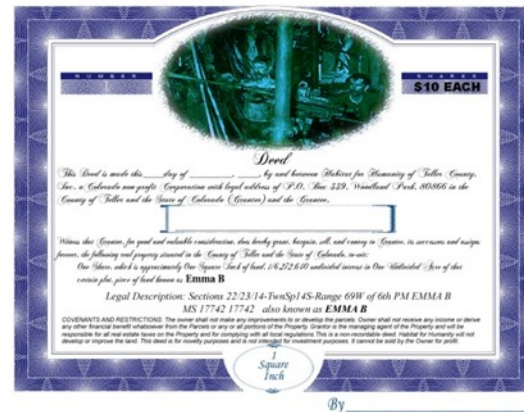

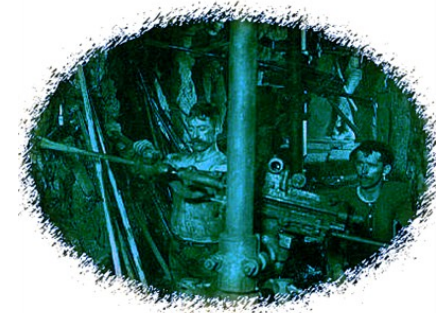

Proceeds from the sale of shares help fund construction of Habitat for Humanity homes in Teller County, Colorado. Habitat uses volunteer labor to build homes in partnership with low-income families in Teller County. Since 2000, Habitat has built 23 homes, including single family homes and multi-unit town homes.



SINGLE FAMILY HOMES

Nick, Leslie, Jael, Esther, Caleb, Haylee, moved into the home Dec. 21, 2009 that they built in partnership with Habitat for Humanity. This is a new and wonderful starting place for them and a great place to raise their children. They have a safe, decent, energy efficient home with a yard and plenty of space for the children to run and grow



The home was green-built using Insulated Concrete Forms from footing to roof line. This was the first Teller County Habitat home that includes a one car garage. The family is happy in their new home and continues to work with Habitat to help other families qualify for the Habitat program, and a home with a no-profit mortgage.

Las Casas at Forest Edge



Las Casas at Forest Edge, a seven-unit townhouse project in Woodland Park, was started in the spring of 2010. Phase One, a three-unit building, will be completed in 2011. Construction of Phase Two, a four-unit building, will begin in 2012.

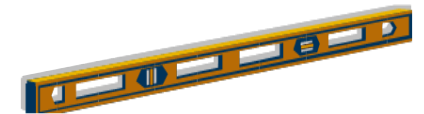
Las Casas will be home for seven families who are now living in unsafe or inadequate housing.



Las Casas is close to schools and downtown. Each unit has three bedrooms and 1 1/2 baths on two levels, with a one car garage and additional parking space. Built in the Southwestern style, they have nice views and lots of space for the children to play.
