Construction Volunteer Position Description

Construction volunteers are the engines that move our building projects forward! Construction volunteers assist with all stages of construction throughout the year to help build decent, affordable homes for our partner families.

Position Tasks: *Tasks may vary depending on construction schedule and weather.* Specific tasks may include, but are not limited to, site preparation, foundation work, framing, flooring, insulation, drywall, roofing, siding, painting, finish work, and site cleanup and maintenance as necessary.

Qualifications: No qualifications necessary! Habitat homes are built by willing hands and loving hearts. Our site supervisor is happy to teach any skills you may need.

Shifts: Workdays at the construction site are Wednesday through Saturday, 8:30AM – 4:30PM. Plan to bring a lunch, and be prepared for the weather! Full and half day shifts are available. Training Required: Volunteers must attend an orientation, fill out our Volunteer Waiver form, and watch a short safety video. Any other training will be provided on the job site and throughout the year.
